Industry Risks

Mechcon Welding and Fabrication Pty Ltd acknowledges the potential risks of modern slavery practices within our supply chain and the broader steel fabrication industry. Our risk assessment has identified several key areas of concern:

Raw Material Extraction and Steel Processing:

Manufacturing and Production Processes:

Workers involved in steel manufacturing and production can face significant health and safety risks, often with inadequate protections, increasing the potential for exploitation.

Indirect Goods and Services:

The procurement of indirect goods, such as clothing for our workforce, involves sourcing materials from regions known for modern slavery incidents within the textile and clothing industries. These supply chains are prone to issues like low wages, poor working conditions, excessive working hours, and child labour.



Subcontracting and Outsourcing:

The use of subcontractors and outsourced services can sometimes lead to sham contracting practices, where workers' rights are undermined and exploitation is more likely to occur.

Steel Fabrication and Installation Machinery:

The complex global supply chains for the machinery and equipment used in steel fabrication and installation heighten the risk of labour exploitation and forced labour, due to the diverse sourcing of materials worldwide.

Mechcon is committed to combating these risks through rigorous supplier assessments, implementing strict ethical standards, and fostering transparency within our operations and supply chains.

Our Commitment
